Douglas looked to blunt Lincoln's arguments during the debates by casting him as a radical Black Republican, accusing him of advocating for the social and legal equality of the races. Though he opposed slavery on moral grounds, Douglas also wanted to deny citizenship to all African Americans, which the Supreme Court had ruled in the Dred Scott case. In his rebuttal, Lincoln offered one of his most quotable moments: "I protest against the counterfeit logic which concludes that because I do not want a black woman for a slave, I must necessarily want her for a wife."
