4.1.4

The Productivity Property is used to compute a lower bound on the λ of a polynomial term when the lower bound for each term in the polynomial is known. The resulting term is an upper bound guaranteed to represent a minimum. (Also see the [Bounds](#) chapter.) In general, the Distribution Property is implemented as

$$\text{min}(f(x)) \leq f(x) \leq \text{max}(f(x)) \quad \text{for } f(x) = \sum a_i x^i$$
