

CPR Quality

- Push-hard (at least 2 inches [5 cm]) and fast (100–120/min) and allow complete chest recoil.
- Minimize interruptions in compressions.
- Avoid excessive ventilation.
- Rotate compressor every 2 minutes, or sooner if fatigued.
- If no advanced airway, 30:2 compression:ventilation ratio.
- Quantitative waveform capnography
 - If $\text{EtCO}_2 < 10$ mm Hg, attempt to improve CPR quality.
- Intra-arterial pressure
 - If relaxation phase (diastolic) pressure <60 mm Hg, attempt to improve CPR quality.

Shock Energy for Defibrillation

- Defibrillator manufacturer recommendation (e.g., initial dose of 120–200 J; if unknown, use maximum available). Second and subsequent doses should be double, and higher doses may be considered.
- Maximum: 360 J

Drug Therapy

- Epinephrine: NVO doses:
 - 1 mg every 3–5 minutes
 - Ampicardine NVO doses:
 - First dose: 200 mg bolus
 - Second dose: 100 mg

Advanced Airway

- Endotracheal intubation or supraglottic advanced airway
- Waveform capnography or continuously to confirm and monitor ET tube placement
- Once advanced airway in place, give 1 breath every 6 seconds (10 breaths/min) with continuous chest compressions

Pulseless Electrical Activity (PEA)

- Pulse and blood pressure
- Abrupt, sustained increase in EtCO_2 , typically 240 mm Hg
- Concurrent arterial pressure waves with intra-arterial monitoring

Reversible Causes

- Hypovolemia
- Hypoxia
- Hypoglycemia (sudden)
- Hypothermia
- Tension pneumothorax
- Thrombocytopenia
- Thrombocytopenia, pulmonary
- Thrombocytopenia, coronary
