When Money Grew on Trees Greg Gordon, 2014-04-02 Born in the timber colony of New Brunswick Maine in 1848 Andrew Benoni Hammond got off to an inauspicious start as a teenage lumberjack By his death in 1934 Hammond had built an empire of wood that stretched from Puget Sound to Arizona and in the process had reshaped the American West and the nation's way of doing business *When Money Grew on Trees* follows Hammond from the rough and tumble world of mid nineteenth century New Brunswick to frontier Montana and the forests of Northern California from lowly lumberjack to unrivaled timber baron Although he began his career as a pioneer entrepreneur Hammond unlike many of his associates successfully negotiated the transition to corporate businessman Against the backdrop of western expansion and nation
