Using data from surveys, experiments and Americans' own words we explore the content of partisan stereotypes and find that they come in three main flavors: parties as their own tribes, coalitions of other tribes or vehicles for political issues. These different stereotypes influence partisan conflict: people who hold trait-based stereotypes tend to display the highest levels of polarization while holding issue-based stereotypes decreases polarization. This finding suggests that reducing partisan conflict does not require downplaying partisan divisions but shifting the focus to political priorities rather than identity.
