Identify and state the historical significance of the following:

A. Introduction

- a. Identify the main issue of unrest in the year 1848.
 - i. In 1848, the war with Mexico had ended with the the treaty of Guadalupe Hidalgo. However the end of the war brought a new round of political warfare in the United States. The United States had received Texas and California, as well as all the land area in between. This new territory that was acquired raised the burning issue of slave states vs. free states.

B. The Popular Sovereignty Panacea

- a. Why would the two great political parties be considered a bond of national unity?
 - i. The two great political parties were a vital bond of national unity because each enjoyed powerful support in both North and South. If the parties were based on purley sectional groupings, the union would be in trouble.
- b. Who did the Democrats favor as a presidential nominee and what was the party and the nominee's stance on the slavery issue?
 - i. The Democrats favored General Lewis Cass, a veteran of the war of 1812. Despite being a senator and diplomat, he was pompous and some of his enemies were quick to point out that Cass rhymes with jackass.
 - ii. The democratic platform stayed silent on the burning issue of slavery, preferring to avoid all topics about it.
 - iii. Cass, on the other hand, was reputed father of "popular sovereignty." This was the doctrine that stated that the sovereign people of a territory, under the general principles of the Constitution, should themselves determine the status of slavery.
- c. Why did the doctrine of popular sovereignty appeal to so many?
 - i. The public liked popular sovereignty because it accorded with the democratic tradition of self-determination.
 - ii. Politicians liked it because it seemed a comfortable compromise between the abolitionist bid for a ban on slavery in the territories and southern demands that Congress protect slavery in the territories.
- d. What was the one fatal flaw of popular sovereignty?
 - i. Popular sovereignty helped to spread the blight of slavery, despite the intention of dissolving the national issue into local issues.
