- It offers a diagnosis of the suffering of mankind and provides a formula for individuals to resolve that suffering.
- It offers a moral code based on compassion and non-violence, and through meditation a way to achieve spiritual insight.
- Buddhism philosophy avoided speculative thought on metaphysics, ethics and epistemology but was based instead on empirical evidence gained by the sense organs.
