

Using the American Psychological Association (APA) Style Guidelines to Report Experimental Results

Empirical Software Engineering does not exist in a vacuum. Other fields have developed techniques for both conducting empirical studies and reporting results and theories to practitioners and researchers. Our field can learn much by observing and, in some cases, adopting other fields' best practices and proven solutions.

Two current problems that we are facing center around the issues of replication and meta-analysis. Studies need to be replicated to ensure that the results are generalizable to other situations. Meta-analysis allows us, as researchers, to combine results across several studies to test theories and again ensure generalizability of results.

However, without adequate reporting, these problems will never be resolved. One cannot replicate a study unless one completely understands the method used to conduct the study. Likewise, one cannot conduct meta-analyses unless one understands the design of the study.

The problems of reporting and its relation to replication and meta-analysis have been faced in psychology. The APA Style Guidelines were created to resolve these issues. They have evolved over approximately seventy years to allow for adequate reporting of experimental results. Thus, it behooves us as empiricists to understand the issues addressed in the APA Style Guidelines and either adopt their solutions, adapt them, or create our own.

This paper will therefore provide an introduction to the APA Style Guidelines talking about each part of a research report in some detail.¹

APA Style Guidelines

The APA Style Guidelines focus on two primary issues. Firstly, the guidelines address typographic features of a manuscript, such as how many spaces to include, how to indent different subsections, how to write numbers, etc. Secondly, the guidelines address content of a manuscript, which includes what to write about and with what specificity. This paper will only review the second of these issues.
