


ACLS Algorithm



CPR Quality

- Push hard (≥2 inches (5 cm) and fast (≥100/min) and allow full recoil after each recoil
- Minimize interruptions in compressions
- Avoid excessive ventilation
- Rotate compressor every 2 minutes
- If no advanced airway, 30:2 compression-ventilation ratio
- Quantitative waveform capnography
 - If $\text{PETCO}_2 < 10 \text{ mm Hg}$, attempt to improve CPR quality
- Intra-arterial pressure
 - If relaxation phase (diastole) pressure <20 mm Hg, attempt to improve CPR quality

Return of Spontaneous Circulation (ROSC)

- Pulse and blood pressure
- Abrupt, sustained increase in PETCO_2 (typically ≥40 mm Hg)
- Spontaneous arterial pressure waves with intra-arterial monitoring

Shock Energy

- Biphasic:** Manufacturer recommended settings (eg, initial dose of 120-200 J; if unknown, use maximum available. Second and subsequent doses should be equivalent, and higher doses may be considered.
- Monophasic:** 360 J

Drug Therapy (IV/IO Doses)

- Epinephrine: 0.5 mg every 3-5 min
- Vancomycin: IV/IO Dose: 40 units can replace first or second dose of epinephrine

- Amiodarone: IV/IO Dose: First dose: 300 mg bolus. Second dose: 150 mg.

Advanced Airway

- Supraglottic advanced airway or endotracheal intubation
- Waveform capnography to confirm and monitor ET tube placement
- 8-10 breaths per minute with continuous chest compressions

Reversible Causes

- Hypovolemia
- Hypoxia
- Hydrogen ion (acidosis)
- Hypo-/hyperkalemia
- Hypothermia
- Tension pneumothorax
- Tamponade, cardiac
- Obstruction
- Thrombosis, pulmonary
- Thrombosis, coronary
