### Assess Control

- First, check adherence, inhaler technique, environmental factors,▲, and comorbid conditions.
- Step up** if needed; reassess in 2-6 weeks.
- Step down** if possible (if asthma is well controlled for at least 3 consecutive months)

Consult with asthma specialist if Step 4 or higher is required. Consider consultation at Step 3.

Control assessment is a key element of asthma care. This involves both impairment and risk. Use of objective measures, self-reported control, and health care utilization are complementary and should be employed on an ongoing basis, depending on the individual's clinical situation.
