Note: Many of these questions are best addressed from a perspective you obtain early by discussing an entire act or an entire several scenes. So read well ahead before you begin answering these questions! You will be more prepared if you are in that act or two ahead in your reading. As you read, constantly jot down questions off your own regarding the events, characters, conflicts, and places. You don't need to answer every question you pose, but you should get accustomed to discussing your questions on the details of your reading. Developing these questions is one of the best ways to begin doing so.

Act 3.2 (as far read, “Act III, Scene 2”)

1. These were great Caesar. Each has a report on marriage. One of these “wifes” has been written by Aemilius Lepidus. The Soothsayer has another; he writes a message to Caesar to “beware the Ides of March.” Who knows of his master from the previous scene? Who has written a third note?
2. Aufidius says this note “touched Caesar’s heart.” Why according to that the topic of the message is of personal interest to Caesar. What does Caesar intend to do with the message?
3. Speculate as to why Caesar probably deals with Aemilius Lepidus’s message in this manner.
4. Caesar asks if “the Belier” is mad. Speculate as to why “the Belier” is.
5. Two of those accompanying Caesar’s message to dissuade the masters. They only do so after Caesar calls attention to them. What operation does he ask to calling attention to them?
6. Caesar is one of the two who would the master of masters. Who is the other?
7. Who does Popilius notice dear to Caesar?
8. What happens to confirm that Caesar is indeed dear to?
9. Who does Caesar dear?
10. Speculate as to what “conspire” (meaning “planned action”) Popilius might be referring, other than the assassination.
11. Brutus advises Caesar to recruit closely related conspirators to Popilius speaks with Caesar. Brutus dismisses these plans as ignorant. Based very basically between this, Popilius and the working done of Caesar by the conspirators, Caesar clearly has a special role in the assassination. Who is Caesar’s role?
12. What year has been planned for the Ides of March in the plot?
13. What year does Brutus, Caesar play in the plot?
14. Who, according to Caesar, has been banished?
15. Caesar actually commits a violent act against Iulius Caesar. In his own words, he treats him “like a dog.” – or dog. What does Caesar do to Iulius?
16. Popilius very briefly (right words on hand) what the conspirators have planned to do in order to shock Caesar into attacking.
17. It appears that Brutus has a very special role. He provides the signal, and a final distraction to Caesar, which causes the actual killing. How does Brutus signal the moment when the killing is to occur?
18. Just before that moment, Caesar makes some claims about this character. At one point he says, “I am Caesar as the Dictator. See,” meaning, he is summarizing in his judgment and commitment to act. What does Brutus do show that this claim is a lie.
