Yet despite a massive injection of resources into the youth justice system, the results achieved have been unimpressive. Reoffending remains a persistent problem and the general public appears to have little confidence in the youth justice system. The time is ripe therefore for a new look at the problem of youth offending and government and society's response to this. This book accompanies the Report of the Independent Commission on Youth Crime and Antisocial Behaviour published 2010. In it leading authorities in the field from a variety of different disciplines review youth crime and different responses to it, focussing particularly on England and Wales but also analysing for comparative purposes the nature of responses in other parts of the world especially Canada.
