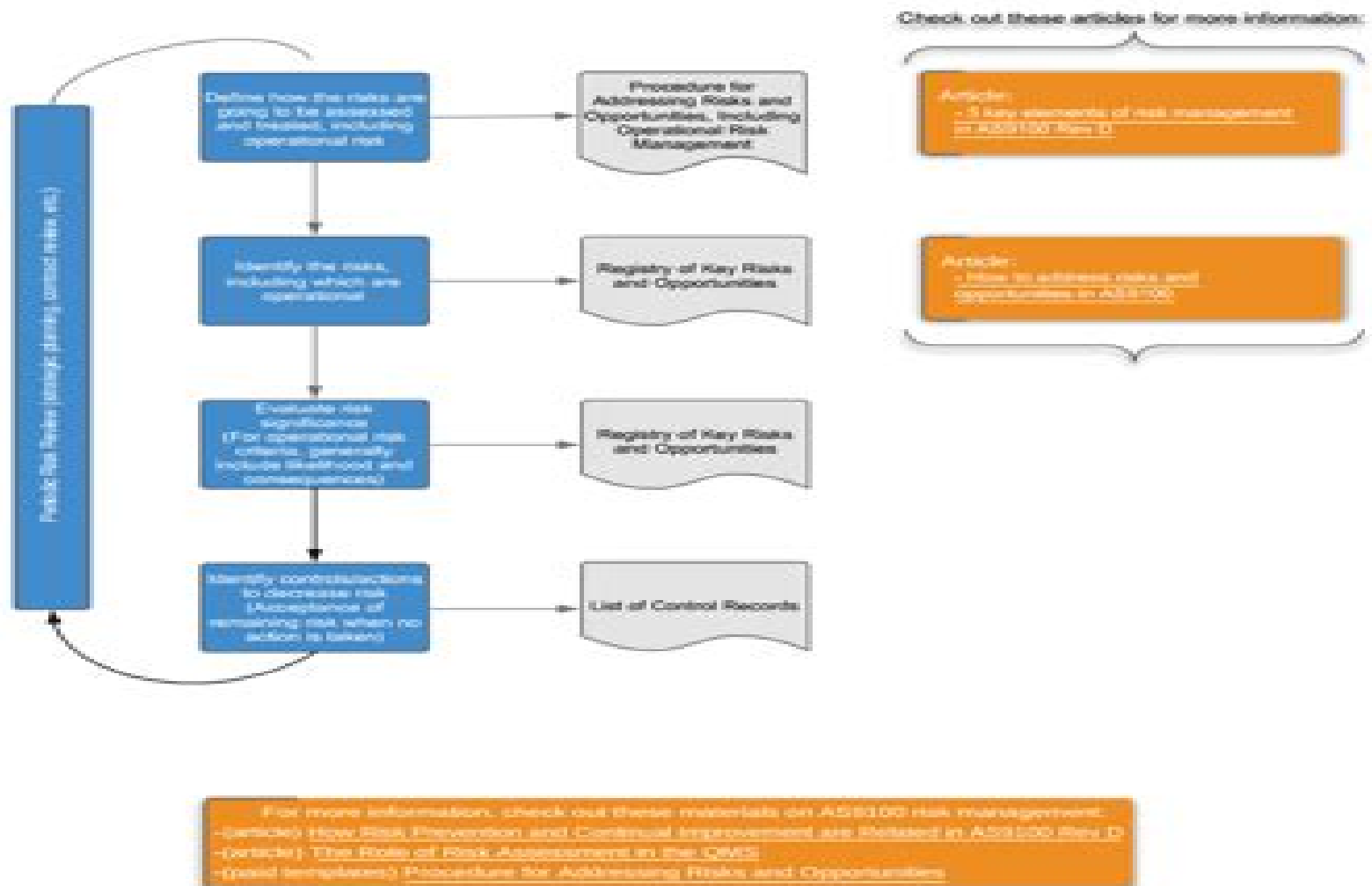


Diagram of the AS9100 Risk Management Process
