Use this formula to solve problems:

Max. dose in mg (by weight or absolute max. mg for each anesthetic type) + #mg per cartridge = max. # cartridges

Max. epinephrine dose for a **cardiac** patient is **0.04 mg** of epinephrine OR about 2 cartridges

Maximum epinephrine does for a **healthy** patient is **0.2 mg** of epinephrine, which roughly equals 11 cartridges of anesthetic with 1:100,000 epinephrine

THEREFORE:

The absolute maximum dose of ANESTHETIC is reached BEFORE this so this amount should never be considered for actual patients (*make these notes on form below if dose EXCEEDS MRO*).
