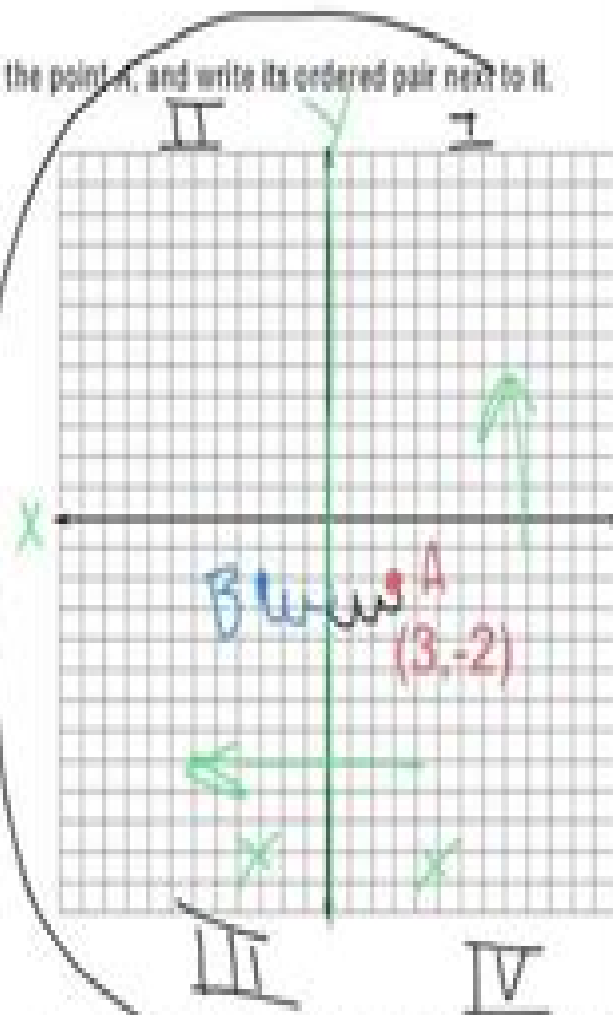


Problem Set

How does the ordered pair for point D compare to the ordered pair for point C ? How does the ordered pair for point D compare to points A and B ?
