## BLS Review

- Assess for responsiveness – shake patient and say are you ok?
- Assess airway
- Check breathing
- If not breathing, begin rescue breaths
- If no pulse, begin CPR
- Don't waste time trying to find the pulse
- For a responsive patient, check for a pulse
- Change position to a supine position
- Use the heel of your hand to thrust the patient's chest
- Squeeze the patient's nostrils shut
- Use a pocket mask or your mouth to cover the patient's mouth
- Try to give 100% oxygen during CPR
- Will patient respond to verbal commands?
- If no pulse, begin CPR
- Continue CPR until help arrives

The first step before BLS or ACLS is always to verify scene safety, activate emergency response (call code, get help, etc.)
