


Absurdism

Thomas Nagel puts some question which is raised by absurdism such as 'Even if what we did now were going to matter in a million years, how could that keep our present concerns from being absurd? Whether what we do now will matter in a million years could make the crucial difference only if its mattering in a million years depended on its mattering, period.' (Bendall)

It was believed that man was able to show heroism and dignity even in defeat. After the war, then, there was the tendency to view man as isolated and the universe as possessing no inherent truth value or meaning. Jean Paul Sartre and Albert Camus, for example, viewed the human being as an isolated existent who is cast into an alien universe to conceive the universe as possessing no inherent truth value or meaning and to represent human life in its fruitless search for purpose and meaning as it moves in the nothingness whence it came toward the nothingness where it must end as an existence which is both anguished and absurd. 1.1 M.
