Stand Firm in Jesus

What can we truly count on? There are a lot of things in the world that can be confusing and children will receive many mixed

messages about what and who to believe. Are fables and legends true? What about scary things like ghosts? What can we

trust and believe? We want to remind children of the importance of trusting in Jesus above all things. We may not know all the details of His return, but we can certainly count on it. We know that He died and rose again for our sins. He loves us and redeems us, and we can bring our hopes on Him.

It's sometimes hard to believe in certain ways to earn God's favor and please Him. This can lead to a sense of threat or fear when it comes to considering the Second Coming of Jesus. We might worry over the thought of Christ's return, nervous over how we have acted or lived. The comforting and beautiful thought we should focus on, though, is that Jesus has died for us and loves us. We don't know when He will return, but we can be confident that our sins are covered and that He keeps His promises.

Passage: 2 Thessalonians 2:1-5, 13-17

Target Audience: Kindergarten-6th grade (older groups or older groups)

Materials Needed: Construction paper, markers, stickers, scissors, tape, glue, paper board tubes, empty boxes, cotton balls, rug (if optional, depending which activities you choose to use). Object lesson prop can include any items representing fear or "founded" elements, cross, printed Bible.
