The book pedagogy is developed as a well annotated systematic tutorial with clearly spelled out and unified nomenclature derived from the author's own modeling efforts publications and teaching over half a century. Ambiguities in some concepts and tools are clarified and others are rendered more accessible and practical. The latter include novel qualitative theory and methodologies for recognizing dynamical signatures in data using structural multicompartmental and network models and graph theory and analyzing structural and measurement data models for quantification feasibility. The level is basic to intermediate with much emphasis on biomodeling from real biodata for use in real applications. Introductory coverage of core mathematical concepts such as linear and nonlinear differential and difference equations, Laplace transforms, linear algebra, probability, statistics, and stochastics topics. The pertinent biology, biochemistry, biophysics, or pharmacology for modeling are provided to support understanding the amalgam of math modeling with life sciences. Strong emphasis on quantifying as well as building and analyzing biomodels includes methodology and computational tools for parameter identifiability and sensitivity analysis, parameter estimation from real data, model distinguishability and simplification, and practical bioexperiment design and optimization. Companion website provides solutions and program code for examples and exercises using Matlab, Simulink, VisSim, SimBiology, SAAMII, AMIGO, Copasi, and SBML coded models. A full set of PowerPoint slides are available from the author for teaching from his textbook. He uses them to teach a 10 week quarter upper division course at UCLA which meets twice a week so there are 20 lectures. They can easily be augmented or stretched for a 15 week semester course. Importantly the slides are editable so they can be readily adapted to a lecturer's personal style and course content needs. The lectures are based on excerpts from 12 of the first 13 chapters of DSBMS. They are designed to highlight the key course material as a study guide and structure for students following the full text content.

For the evaluation and comparison of the performances of novel and competing computational methods one major bottleneck is the availability of realistic test problems. We present an approach for performing realistic simulation studies for analyses of time course data as they are typically measured in systems biology. Since the design of experiments in practice depends on the process of interest our approach considers the size and the dynamics of the mathematical model which is intended to be used for the simulation study. To this end we used 19 published systems biology models with experimental data and evaluated the relationship between model features e.g. the size and the dynamics and features of the measurements such as the number and type of observed quantities the number and the selection of measurement times and the magnitude of measurement errors. Based on these typical relationships our novel approach enables suggestions of realistic simulation study designs in the systems biology context and the realistic generation of simulated data for any dynamic model. The approach is demonstrated on three models in detail and its performance is validated on nine models by comparing ODE integration parameter optimization and parameter identifiability. The presented approach enables more realistic and less biased benchmark studies and thereby constitutes an important tool for the development of novel methods for dynamic modeling.

A general goal of systems biology is to acquire a detailed understanding of the dynamics of living systems by relating functional properties of whole systems with the interactions of their constituents Often this goal is tackled through computer simulation A number of different formalisms are currently used to construct numerical representations of biological systems and a certain wealth of models is proposed using ad hoc methods There arises an interesting question of to what extent these models can be reused and composed together or in a larger framework In this thesis we propose BioRica as a means to circumvent the difficulty of incorporating disparate approaches in the same modeling study BioRica is an extension of the AltaRica specification language to describe hierarchical non deterministic General Semi Markov processes We first extend the syntax and automata semantics of AltaRica in order to account for stochastic labeling We then provide a semantics to BioRica programs in terms of stochastic transition systems that are transition systems with stochastic labeling We then develop numerical methods to symbolically compute the probability of a given finite path in a stochastic transition systems We then define algorithms and rules to compile a BioRica system into a stand alone C simulator that simulates the underlying stochastic process We also present language extensions that enables the modeler to include into a BioRica hierarchical systems nodes that use numerical libraries e g Mathematica Matlab GSL Such nodes can be used to perform numerical integration or flux balance analysis during discrete event simulation We then consider the problem of using models with uncertain parameter values Quantitative models in Systems Biology depend on a large number of free parameters whose values completely determine behavior of models Some range of parameter values produce similar system dynamics making it possible to define general trends for trajectories of the system e g oscillating behavior for some parameter values In this work we defined an automata based formalism to describe the qualitative behavior of systems dynamics Qualitative behaviors are represented by finite transition systems whose states contain predicate valuation and whose transitions are labeled by probabilistic delays We provide algorithms to automatically build such automata representation by using random sampling over the parameter space and algorithms to compare and cluster the resulting qualitative transition system Finally we validate our approach by studying a rejuvenation effect in yeasts cells population by

using a hierarchical population model defined in BioRica Models of ageing for yeast cells aim to provide insight into the general biological processes of ageing For this study we used the BioRica framework to generate a hierarchical simulation tool that allows dynamic creation of entities during simulation The predictions of our hierarchical mathematical model has been validated experimentally by the micro biology laboratory of Gothenburg **IEE Proceedings** ,2006
