- Set notation:  $\{1, 2, 3\}$ ,  $\{\{1, 2\}, \{3\}, \{1, 2, 3\}\}$ ,  $\{1, 2, 3, \dots\}$ ,  $\emptyset$ ,  $\{x \in \mathbb{R} \mid -3 < x < 6\}$ .
- Set  $A$  is called a *subset* of Set  $B$ , written as  $A \subseteq B$ , when  $\forall x, x \in A \rightarrow x \in B$ .
- $A$  is a *proper subset* of  $B$ , when  $A$  is a subset of  $B$  and  $\exists x \in B$  and  $x \notin A$ .
- Visual representation sets: *Venn diagrams*.
- Note the distinction between  $\subseteq$  (set containment) and  $\in$  (set membership).
