As a consequence of this prosecution, Baudelaire was fined 300 francs. Six poems from the work were suppressed, and the ban on their publication was not lifted in France until 1949. These poems were: Lesbos, Femmes damnées, la pâle clarté, or Women Doomed, In the pale glimmer; Le Léthé or Léthélle, qui est trop gaie, or To Her Who Is Too Joyful; Les Bijoux or The Jewels; and Les Métamorphoses du Vampire or The Vampire's Metamorphoses. These were later published in Brussels in a small volume entitled Les pavés Scraps or Jetsam. On the other hand, upon reading The Swan or Le Cygne from Les Fleurs du mal, Victor Hugo announced that Baudelaire had created un nouveau frisson, a new shudder, a new thrill in literature. In the wake of the prosecution, a second edition was issued in 1861, which added 35 new poems, removed the six suppressed poems, and added a new section entitled Tableaux Parisiens. A posthumous third edition, with a preface by Thophile Gautier and including 14 previously unpublished poems, was issued in 1868.
